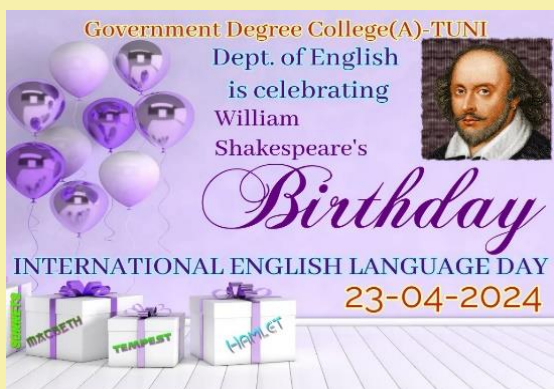
International English Language Day
