Government Degree College came into existence in 1980 which was initially affiliated to Andhra University with B.A. & B.Com Sections. Introduced Science sections in 1988 and got UGC -2(f) & 12 B recognition in 1988. Catering the educational needs of around 1000 students from the economically marginalized sections of the rural areas.

Since 2012, the college has been affiliated with Adi Kavi Nannaya University. The college offers a diverse range of programs catering to various disciplines. There are 12 departments encompassing conventional and restructured undergraduate programs, along with a postgraduate program. In its pursuit of academic excellence, the college achieved autonomous status in 2017.

In 2017, three restructured science programs B.Sc. Maths, Chemistry, Computer Science; B.Sc. Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science; and B.Com. Computer Applications were introduced. Meeting the growing interest in Life Sciences, a conventional B.Sc. Botany, Zoology, Chemistry program was added in 2018. Further catering to regional demands, B.Voc. Pharmaceutical Chemistry and B.Com. Accounting & Taxation programs were introduced in 2020. The year 2021 saw the introduction of the restructured B.Sc. Mathematics, Physics, and Web technology program.

From PHC Thetagunta five member staff came conduct Hemoglobin blood tests for 120 member women students.

The healthy range of hemoglobin for women is 11.6 to 15 grams per deciliter. 57 member students are identified below 11.6 gm/dl as per the blood reports and WEC would like to educate the women students to take necessary precautions to improve blood hemoglobin levels.
